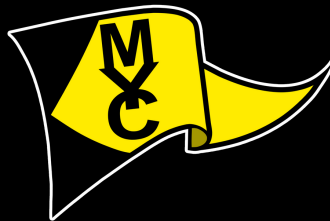

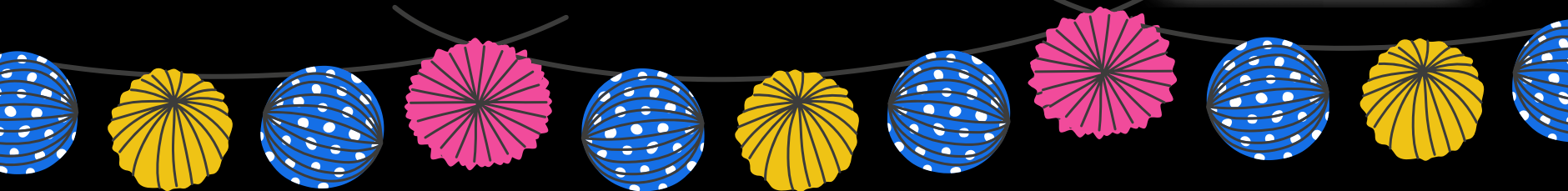

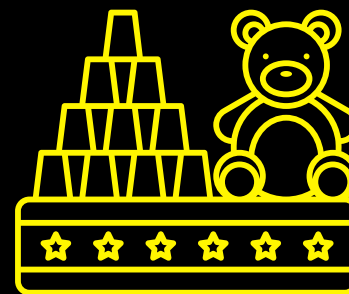

The Hudson River Yacht Racing Association ([HRYRA](http://www.hryra.org)) is the local arm of US Sailing (America's national sailing organization). Yacht racing might bring to mind blue blazers and exclusive private clubs but it's really an open arena where anyone, well you need a boat (or better know someone with a boat!) can participate.



I heard a sailboat instructor once say to her students; "I can teach you the basics of sailing a boat in an afternoon on the water, but you'll spend the rest of your life becoming a good sailor." Notice of Theft of Boat Trailer

Note from AR Swan, Commodore Ossining Boat and Canoe Club

"For the first time in our history, a trailer was stolen of our property in broad daylight on Wednesday May 18. We did not notice it was missing until our work party Saturday morning.

Thankfully through our security cameras we were able to identify the car and the time taken. The police were able to get a plate number off a local camera and the person was identified and caught. But they knew exactly what they were looking for.

I wanted to share because the police said they are seeing a huge surge in crimes like these due to the rising costs and rarity of trailers in the market."

This incident should serve as a reminder to all clubs and individual members who own trailers to use tongue locks, remove plates, etc to properly secure their trailers.

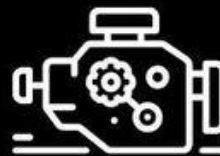
