Hudson River PCBs Superfund Site – Excerpt from the Meeting Summary

MEETING IN BRIEF

The Community Advisory Group (CAG) for the Hudson River PCBs Superfund Site met virtually on Thursday, October 5, 2023. EPA staff presented updates on the progress of the Allen Mill/Powerhouse deconstruction in Hudson Falls; the current Five-Year Review (FYR) status and schedule; and the ongoing work on the Floodplain comprehensive study. The NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) briefed the group on the status of seven active state-led remediation projects adjacent to the Hudson River. EPA/DEC responded to follow-up questions from CAG members as each topic was discussed. The CAG facilitator (CBI) also provided an update on the CAG expansion efforts. CAG members approved a revision to the CAG Operating Procedures to increase the number of members on the CAG.

National Lighthouse Museum flyer p1






Located on the site of the United States Light House Service (USLHS) General Depot, the National Lighthouse Museum educates visitors about the history and technology of the nation's lighthouses and lightships. The General Depot was the national headquarters, testing ground, and distribution center for all materials and equipment used by light keepers and USLHS personnel from 1864 to 1939. Once a lively and bustling site of eighteen buildings, only seven survive today, which include underground oil vaults.

The Museum is situated on a ten acre historic site that is a short walk from the Staten Island Ferry Terminal. The adjacent waterfront plaza features several historic buildings and offers spectacular views of New York Harbor. Upon arrival, visitors can expect

a short introduction to the historic site and museum, before embarking on a selfguided tour of its exhibits.
